## *The Legacy of George & Martha Briddell*

*The Legacy and Community scholarships  
are made possible by the Briddell Family Foundation*

### **Scholarship Criteria:**

The Scholarship is administered by The Briddell Family Foundation which establishes award criteria and has sole authority for selecting recipients. Students meeting the general Foundation scholarship criteria may be considered for the scholarship awards.

### **Eligibility:**

Briddell Family Foundation scholarships are open to legal US residents and the District of Columbia. Applicants must be a student who plans to enroll, or who is already enrolled, in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.

### **Scholarships Available:**

- **Legacy Scholarship:** The purpose of the George and Martha Briddell Legacy Scholarship is to assist their descendants as they further their education. Applicants must be a dependent child (including an adopted or stepchild) of a descendent of George and Martha Briddell. Scholarships will be awarded to students meeting the eligibility requirements and pursuing an undergraduate degree in their desired course of study.
- **Community Scholarship:** The purpose of the Community Scholarship is to encourage and reward students who make significant contributions to their communities. Scholarships will be awarded to students meeting the eligibility requirements and pursuing an undergraduate degree in their desired course of study.

### **Awards:**

Scholarship payments will be processed towards the cost of tuition by December 31. Awards will be sent directly to the university or institution in which the student is enrolled. A copy of the award notification will also be sent to the recipient. All decisions are final and done in accordance with Briddell Foundation rules and guidelines. Recipients may re-apply in subsequent years while they are in college.

### **Appearances:**

Recipients are required to be active Briddell Family Foundation student members for a full calendar year from the date the award is given. Recipients may also be asked to participate in interviews, make guest appearances, host events, travel, perform humanitarian work, and represent the Foundation in various Foundation sponsored events. The Briddell Family Foundation understands the commitment and time needed to focus on a college course of study. Request for appearances will be given with adequate time for our recipients to arrange for study and other academic and personal commitments. Repeated failure to participate in Foundation activities and appearance request will result in forfeiture and ineligibility for future Foundation scholarships.

### **Deadline:**

The deadline for the scholarship is **September 30**.

### **Applications:**

### **To be considered for these scholarship(s), you must:**

- \*Complete the application along with your essay response**
- \*Submit a copy of your college acceptance letter**
- \*Obtain at least two letters of recommendation from a non-family member**
- \*Submit an official copy of your most recent high school or college transcript**

Recommendation letters should include how long the reference has known the applicant and in what capacity.

## **Required Documents**

All Applications must include the following required documents.

A brief statement of your career goals

### **Required Essays**

A statement of your personal achievements: You may attach a resume in lieu of this. Personal achievements should include:

- I. Extra-curricular activities or office(s) held, year and position held
- II. Employment
- III. Awards

In what ways have you participated in community service or given back to your community in the last 2 years?

References: List at least three (3) references and their relationship to you (i.e., teacher, employer, clergy, coach, and/or counselor). Submit letter(s) of recommendations with your application. Include a phone number and an e-mail address.

If a “third party” is submitting documents on your behalf, please familiarize them with the submission requirements as outlined in the application process document.
