MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

The Expectations of Membership embody aspirational ethical standards. The aspirational ethical standards describe the conduct that individuals strive to uphold as Foundation members. Although adherence to the aspirational ethical standards is not easily measured, conducting themselves in accordance with these ethical standards is an expectation that members have of themselves as members of the community and the Briddell Family Foundation. Among the aspirational ethical concepts which these Expectations of Membership embrace are those of respect, responsibility, fairness, and honesty.

- Conduct myself so as to reflect credit on the Foundation.
- Promote the Foundation and encourage the participation of Partners in Education and new members.
- Maintain an active membership status by renewing membership dues annually.

Tender my resignation from membership if I am, or become, unable to serve in accordance with the provisions of this commitment.

Any violations of these expectations will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis and could result in membership expulsion from the Briddell Family Foundation

Expectations of membership

Comply with all applicable statutes and regulations applying to non-profit organizations and the terms of the Articles of Incorporation, the bylaws, and the policies adopted by the Foundation.

Protect the interests of the Foundation as determined by its purpose, its mission and prudent business practices.

Refrain from using my membership with the Briddell Family Foundation for my own personal advantage or the advantage of any special interests inside or outside of the Foundation.

Protect the confidentiality of private or confidential information to which I become a party as a member of the Foundation, i.e. member directory, financial information, scholarship applicant information etc.

Exercise my vote on Foundation policies and elections.
